

The Finance Committee Meeting of the Iron County Board of Commissioners was called to order on January 16, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. by Finance Chairman Tim Aho and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll call: Lind, Peretto, Aho. All present.

Prosecuting Attorney Powell informed the Committee that Sue Bekkala, Crime Victims Rights Coordinator, is in a grant-funded position and did not get a raise last year. There was an addendum to the Courthouse Union Contract that had stated she was to get what the grant stipulated. However, during the last negotiations, that addendum was not included. The raise in 2014 is 2 cents less than what the grant calls for. The Union has agreed to the amount called for in the grant. She stated she will bring the proposal to the next Regular Board meeting for approval.

County Clerk, Hilberg, asked about the status of the dedicated analog phone line to be used in elections. Finance Chairman Aho said it hopefully will be installed by April.

Treasurer Camps passed out a financial packet.

The Committee reviewed the bills and a motion was made by Peretto, supported by Lind, to approve the bills in the amount of \$288,190.53. Roll call: Ayes 3. Nays 0. Motion carried.
